Dear Lake Minnewawa Association Members,

Due to the State of Minnesota shut down, the Lake Minnewawa Association has been directed by Steve Hirsch, director of the DNR's division of ecological and water resources, to suspend all harvesting operations. The LMA operates the harvesting program under a permit issued by the DNR. This suspension of operation effects all individuals, lake associations, cities, counties, and private companies state wide that have permits for aquatic vegetation control by both chemical and mechanical means.

Once the budget issues have been resolved, we will continue the harvesting operations. Please understand that this suspension is directed by the State of Minnesota and not as a result of a decision made by the Lake Minnewawa Association.
